2020 CHIPPER DAYS

A CHIPPER CREW WILL TRAVEL DOOR-TO-DOOR IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD

All piles must be at roadside before **TUESDAY, AUG. 4**

(Please do not add to your pile after Aug. 4 as we are obtaining contractor bids)

To Participate:

- 1) **PRIOR TO MONDAY, JULY 27, 2020**, fill out the application (reverse side of this sheet) and return it with your check for the **\$50.00** co-pay (made out to "Inverness Fire Department").

THEN...

- 2) **BEFORE AUGUST 4**, create your chipping pile. Stack brush and tree limbs (nothing over 6 inches in diameter) in a loose pile along the roadside with the cut ends facing down and towards the road. The roadway must be kept clear and the site must be accessible to the chipper (see the example below):



- 3) **Your \$50 co-pay is for a maximum of 10 cubic yards of material** (5-feet high by 5-feet wide by 10-feet long). **An additional charge will apply if you put out more than the 10 cubic yard maximum.** The intent of this program is to serve smaller clearing projects; it is not intended to be a substitute for larger tree/clearing work.
 - **WARNING:** Compostable green waste **IS NOT ACCEPTABLE** for chipping (this includes loose leaves, twigs, brambles, vines, garden clippings, etc.).
 - Bushy limbs can be chipped and do not need to be trimmed.
 - Neighbors can combine efforts and share a location (individual fees will still apply).
 - **The chips will be left on site; they will not be hauled away.**
